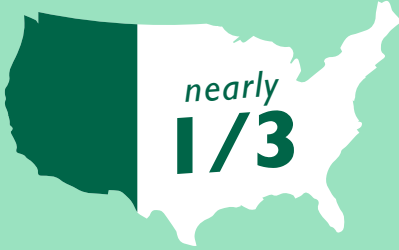


REINCARCERATION

The **BIGGEST SOCIETAL ISSUE** that **NO ONE'S TALKING ABOUT**



nearly **1/3**

of our country (100M Americans) is impacted by mass reincarceration in some way



3 out of 4 people released from prison are **rearrested within 5 years**



30% return to prison within one year of being released¹

Black Americans are disproportionately impacted

The imprisonment rate of **Black males** is nearly

6X that of white males²

The **CYCLE OF REINCARCERATION** has **DEVASTATING EFFECTS**

INDIVIDUAL impact

72% will not find full-time jobs after prison³

On average an individual goes back to prison **7 times**

83% struggle with substance use⁴

More than **50%** have at least one mental illness¹

5X more likely to be homeless³

GENERATIONAL impact

10M children have experienced **parental incarceration** at some point during their childhood⁵

22% When fathers are incarcerated, the **average family income decreases by 22%**⁵

Children of incarcerated parents are more likely to experience **depression, anxiety, low academic performance, school absenteeism and homelessness**⁶

SOCIETAL impact

There are approximately **30 million** individuals in this country who have been **convicted of a felony, devastating communities** all over our nation¹

Majority of crime (55%) committed in the country is by **formerly incarcerated individuals**

Low success rates after prison are a major driver of poverty in the U.S. (even during periods of economic growth)

CONCORDANCE is now...



raising \$50M to scale its model and expand to 11 additional U.S. cities within the next **5 years**

HOLISTIC set of SERVICES

12 essential services under one roof

Concordance is the only program of its kind reducing reincarceration rates through a holistic, integrated and evidence-driven model that includes 12 essential services under one roof, including integrated, personalized support across substance use and mental health treatment, education, job readiness and employment, housing and legal services, and more. **The organization has reduced recidivism rates by 38%.**
